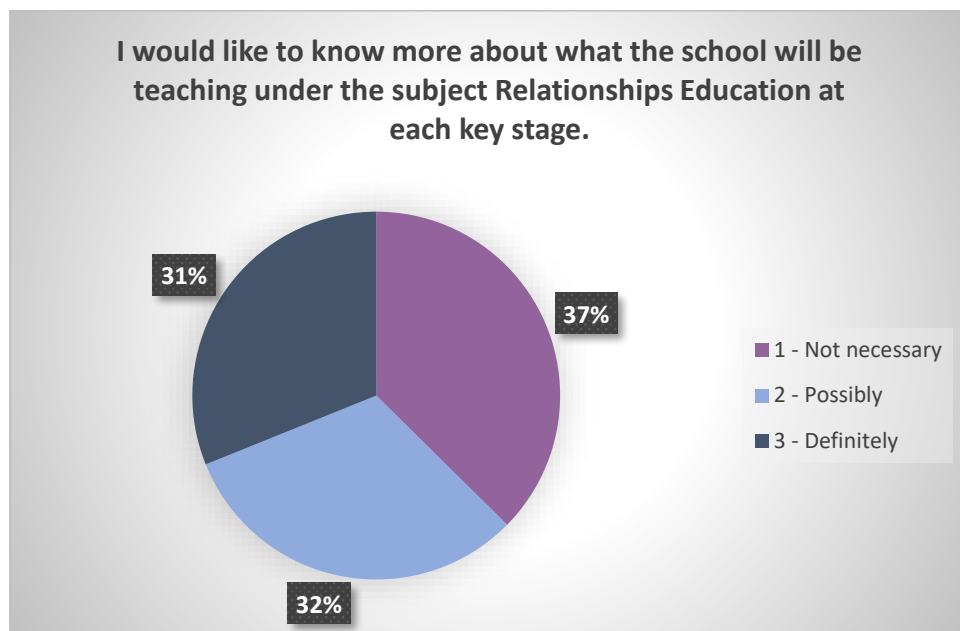
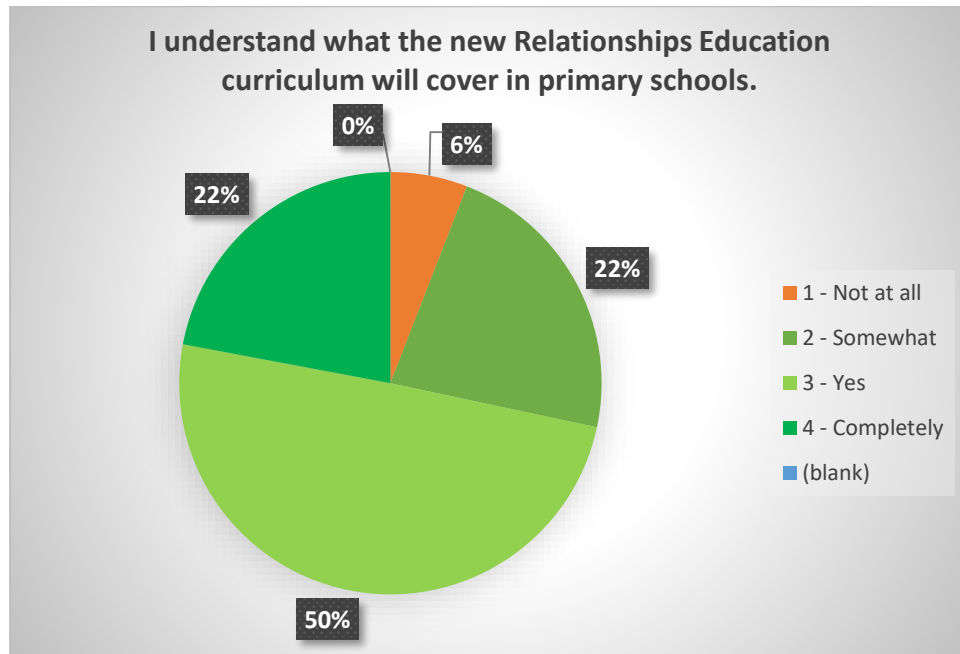
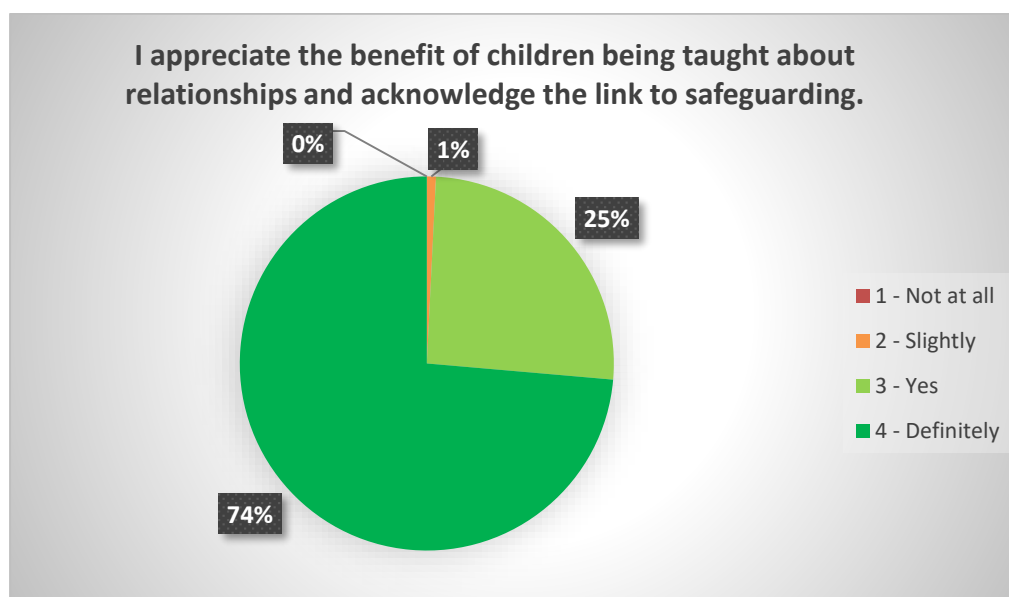
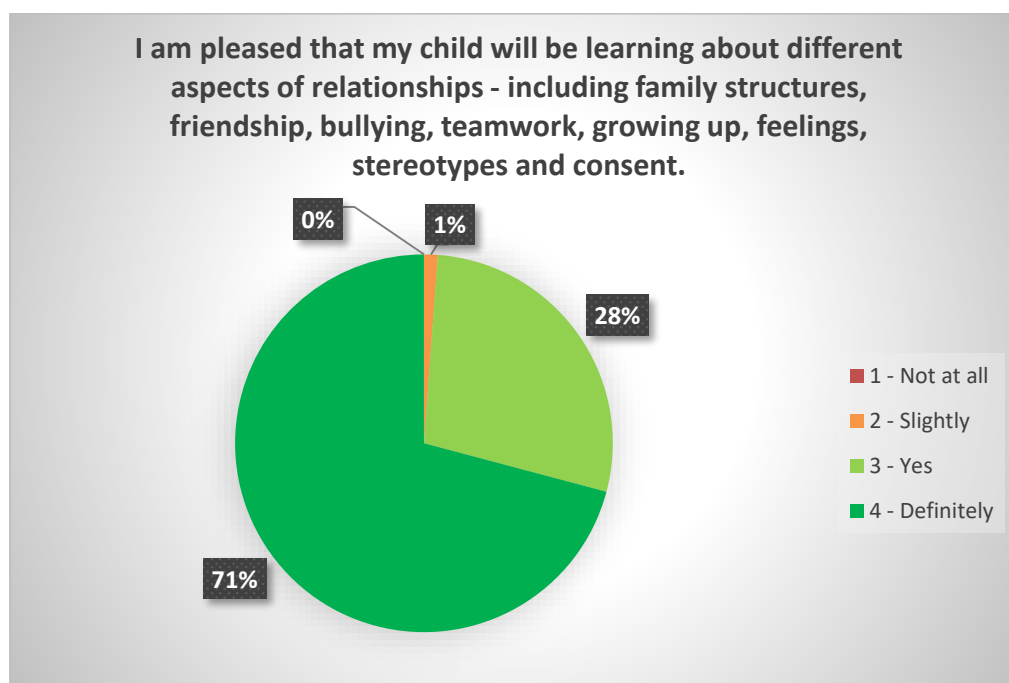
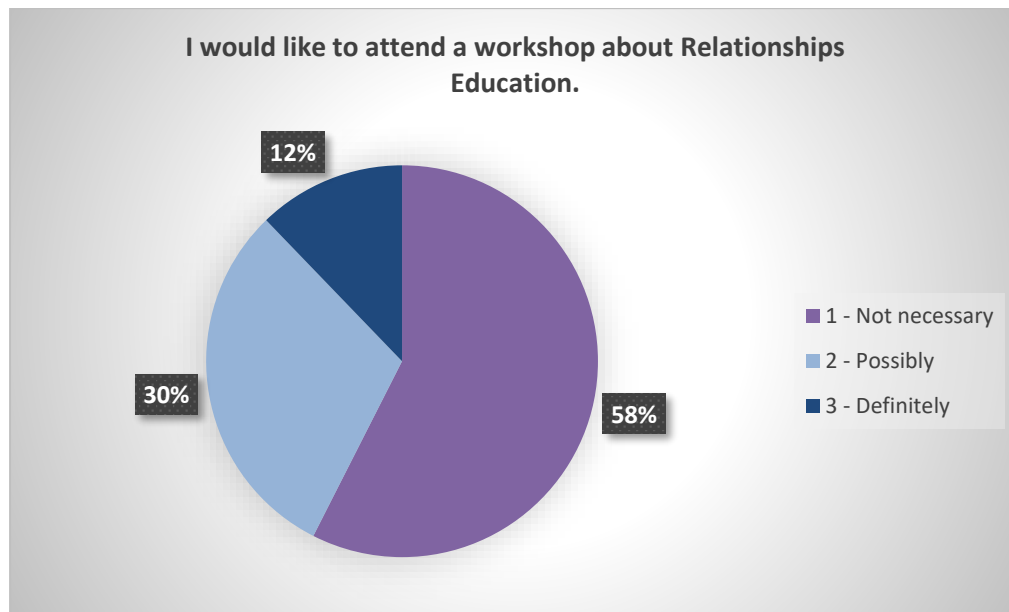
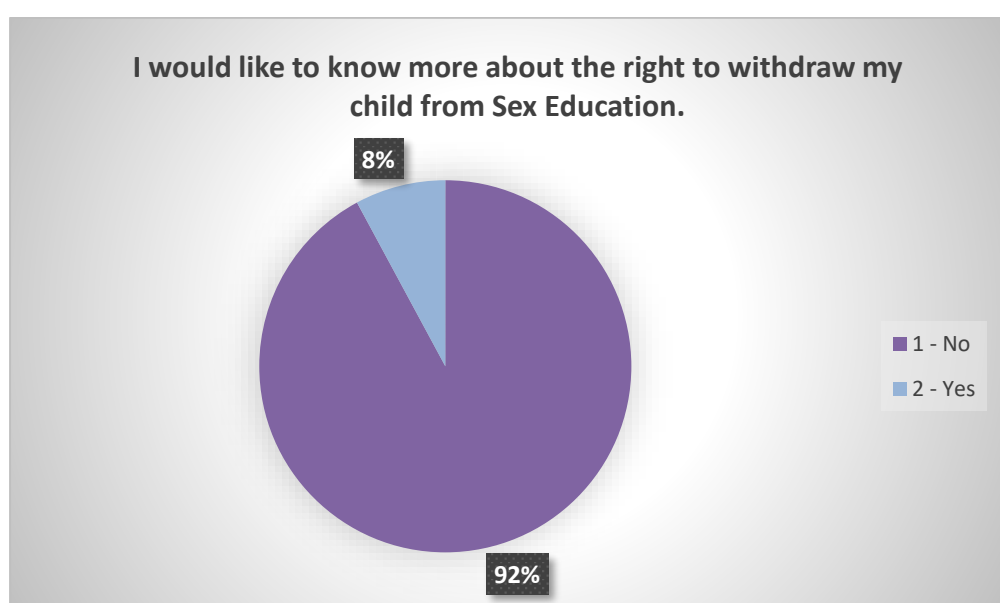
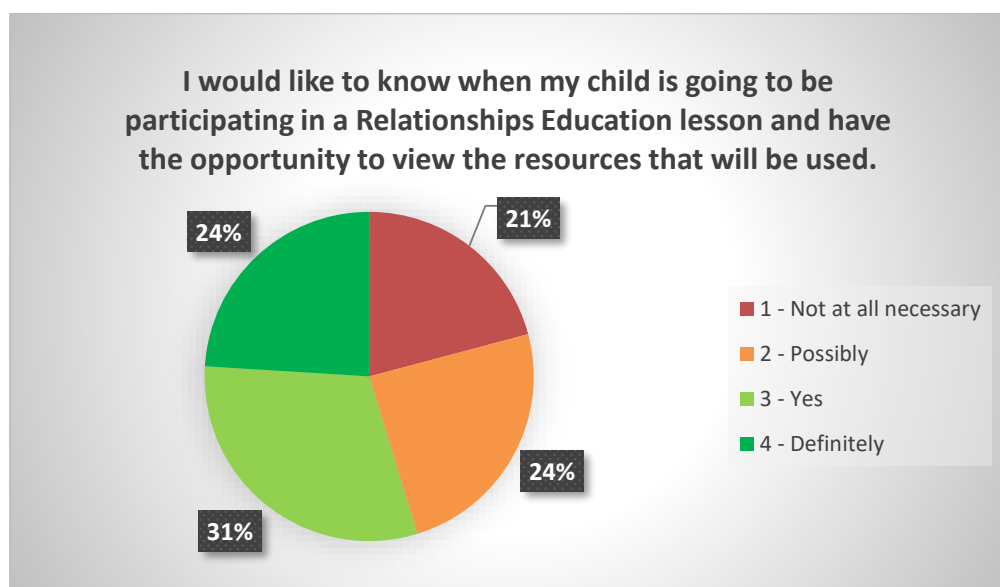
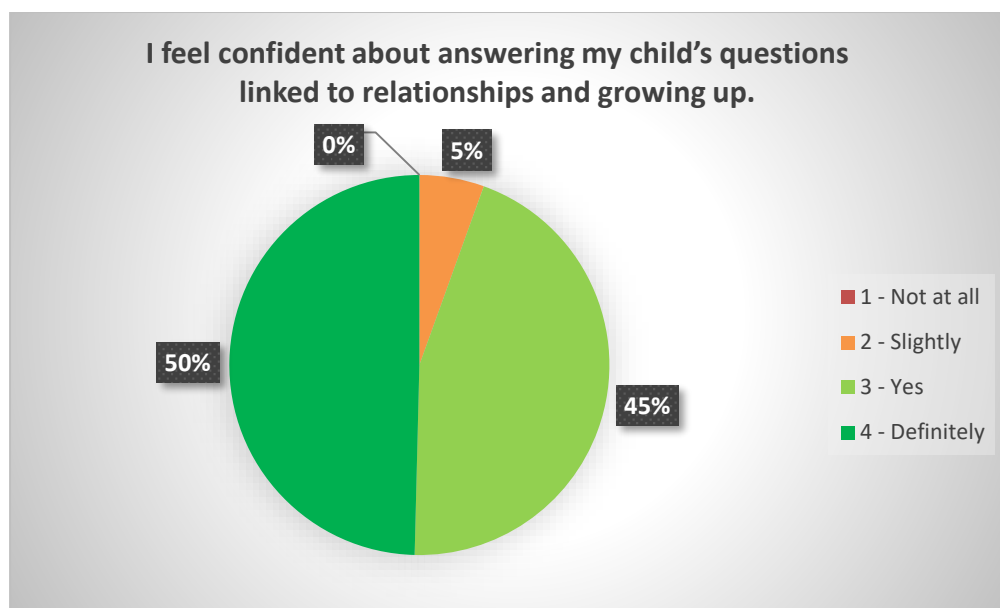


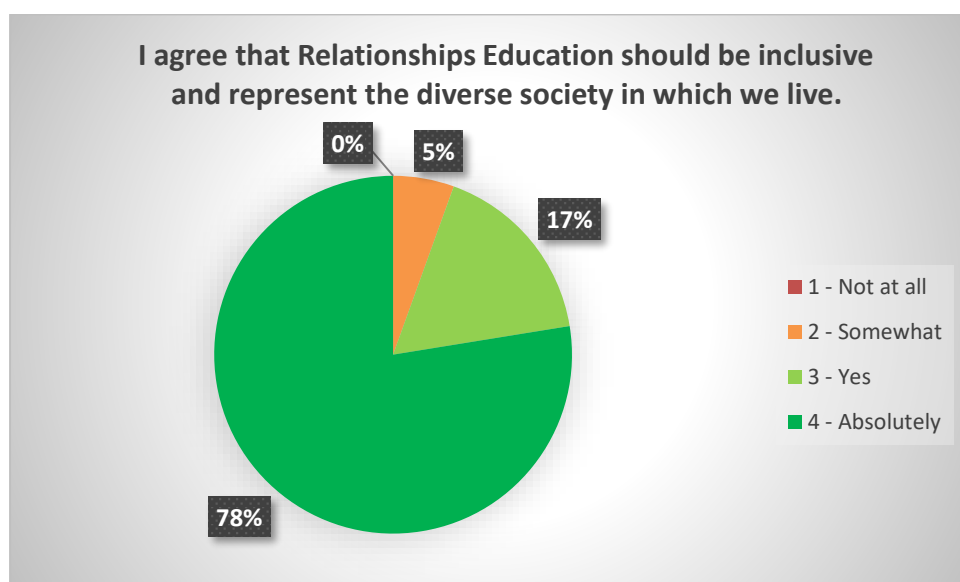
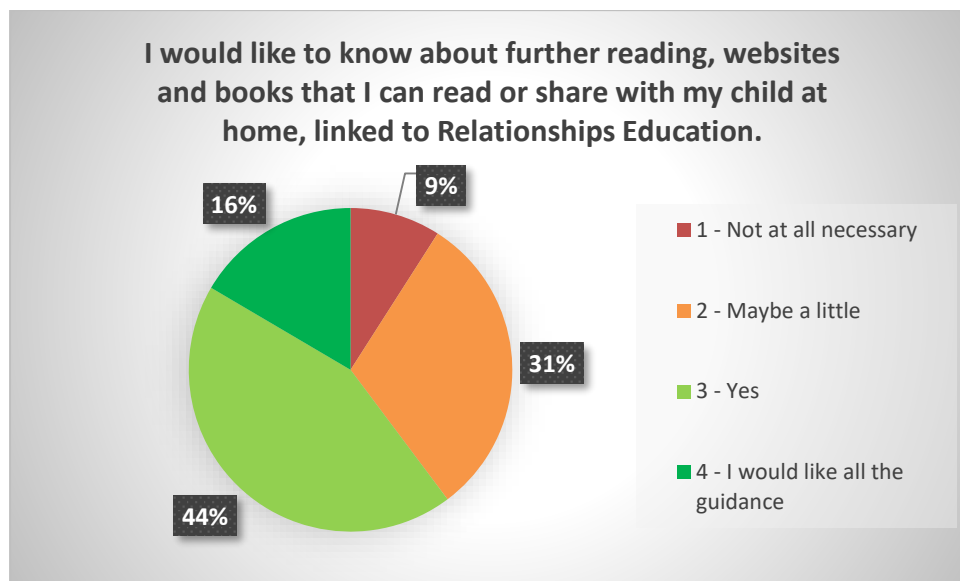
Feedback from the Relationships Education Survey for Parents and Carers (June 2020)

Additional Parent Comments:
