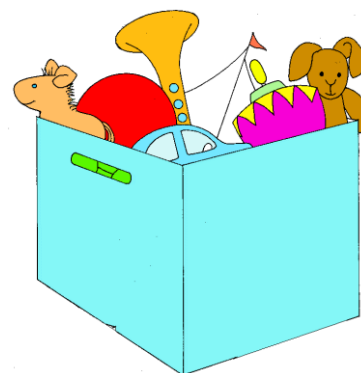

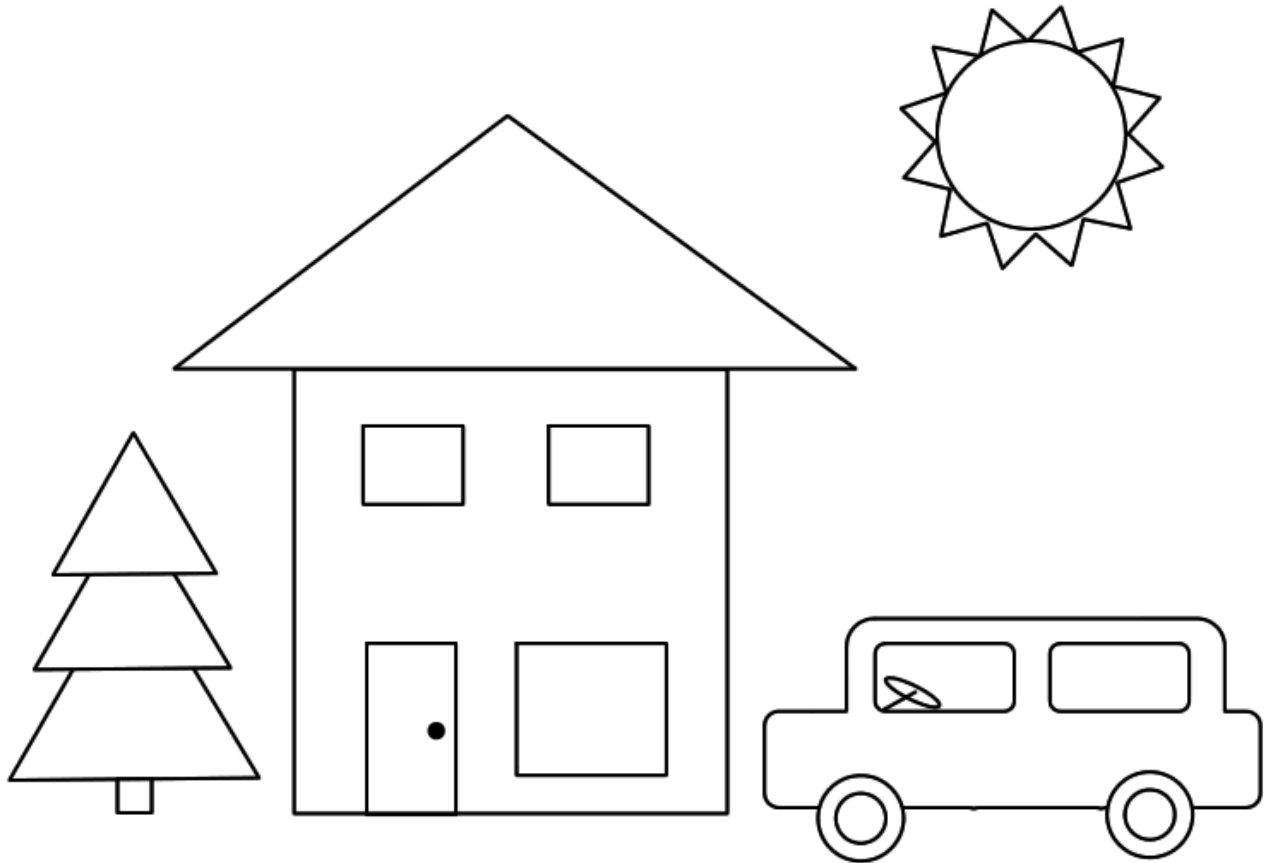

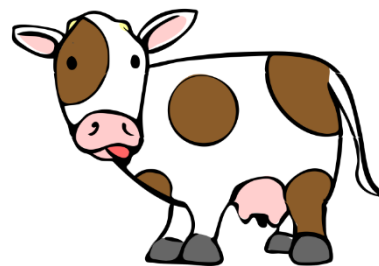

All through the town!

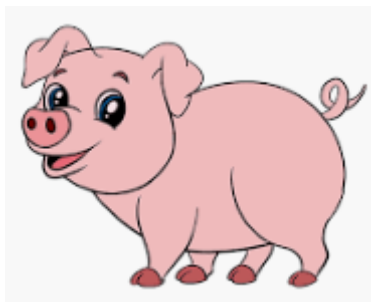

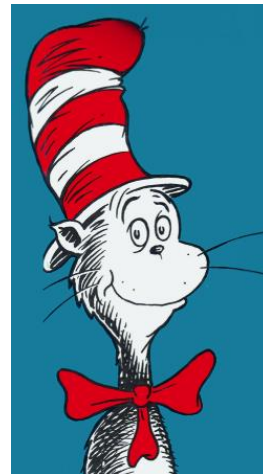
